- **NOTICE!** Because of low participation during the Fall Clean-Up Day, the Town of Glenwood Board has decided to only offer the Spring Clean-Up Day, and to stop offering the Fall Clean-Up Day. This will be the only Town of Glenwood Clean-Up Day in 2026. St. Croix County offers many free events during the year and a free, year-round recycling program, located in Somerset, is available for residents to dispose of electronics and appliances, 5 days a week, for no cost.
- **CURBSIDE GARBAGE!** The Town of Glenwood Board wants to kindly remind residents to **not place refuse containers, especially dumpsters, on the shoulder of the road, within the right of way.** They are best placed in the driveway, off the shoulder line of the road.
- **BURNING PERMITS** The Town of Glenwood does not issue burning permits. However, it is your responsibility to call the St. Croix Dispatch Center @ 800-281-3478 to let them know you are burning. If the Fire Department responds to a call about your fire, and you have not notified the dispatch center, you are responsible for the charges. Also, you must follow all County and State issued burning bans.
- **DOG LICENSES** Please remember that **all dogs need to be licensed.** The Town of Glenwood has contracted with Dedicated Animal Control Services to handle stray dogs. If Dedicated Animal Control Services is called, and they have to come and get your dog, you will be responsible for the bill. The Town of Glenwood dog ordinance can be viewed on the Town of Glenwood website: townofglenwoodstcroix.com. If you need to license a dog, contact Marguerite Quale, Treasurer (715) 977-1085
- **BUILDING PERMITS AND DRIVEWAY PERMITS** are required in the Town of Glenwood. Contact Chairman, Dale Berends, for building permits and Clerk, Lori Obermueller, for driveway permits. Applications for both types of permits are available on the Town of Glenwood website.
