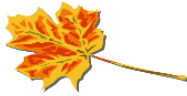


Fall Clean-Up Day

- **General Election - Tuesday, November 5**

October 16 is the deadline to register by mail or online. If you need to register or update your name and address, go to; <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/Register-To-Vote>, or you can contact the town clerk at 715-265-7456 or clerk@tn.glenwood.wi.gov . After this date, you will have to register in person, with the clerk, or register at the polling place the day of the election. **Proof of residence is required.**

October 22 is the first day to vote in person-absentee with the clerk. Please call to make an appointment. 715-265-7456 **Photo ID is required.**

October 31 is the last day for regular and overseas electors to request absentee ballots by mail. Because of mail delivery times, waiting this long is not advised. Call the clerk to see if in person-absentee is an option.

November 1 is the last day to register with the clerk, before the election. After this date, you will have to register at the polling place on Election Day. Also, it is the last day to submit a calendar year absentee ballot request.

November 1 is the last day to vote in person-absentee with the clerk.

- You must purchase a garbage card to bring garbage to the dump. You do not need a garbage card to bring recyclables. The garbage card costs \$100 annually. You can purchase a garbage card by contacting the Town Treasurer, Audrey Maes. **Please call for an appointment**, 715-265-7098 or 715-684-9737. You will also be able to buy a garbage card during clean-up day.
 - **Please note, dumping garbage after dump hours is not allowed.**
 - The Town of Glenwood does not issue burning permits. However, it is your responsibility to call the St. Croix Dispatch Center @ 800-281-3478 to let them know you are burning. If the Fire Department responds to a call about your fire, and you have not notified the dispatch center, you are responsible for the charges. Also, you must follow all County and State issued burning bans.
 - **Building permits and Driveway permits are required in the Town of Glenwood.** Please contact the chairman or clerk for the application.
 - Please remember that **all dogs need to be licensed.** The Town of Glenwood has contracted with Dedicated Animal Control Services to handle stray dogs. The Town of Glenwood dog ordinance can be viewed on the Town of Glenwood website: townofglenwoodstcroix.com. If you need to license a dog, contact Audrey Maes, 715-265-7098 or 715-684-9737.
